**Grant Amounts:** \$100.00-\$1,500.00

**Grant Stipulations:** The project must be conducted and completed within the academic calendar year of the application.

ISCA WILL CONSIDER FUNDING: supplies or materials for students to do such things as create a piece of artwork or literary-arts based work, to create an informal or formal performance based presentation, to learn a new skill beyond the scope of the classroom to enhance the arts curriculum; written materials or software to be used in the activities of the project. The project should engage students/ community in hands on activities that lead to new knowledge, and/or raise awareness of arts education. The concepts addressed in your project should be curriculum based, and the materials necessary to conduct the project should be widely available.

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**MISSION STATEMENT:** Recognizing that arts education supports academic achievement, the mission of the Island School Council for the Arts is to promote and advance art education, by enriching and enhancing the art experience of the youth in the greater Hilton Head Island and Bluffton areas.
